5. EVENTS.

CSM(R) Jan Hauger administered swearing in ceremony to the chapter officers for the term 2017-18 on 9 March 2017.

a. Ohio Military Hall of Fame for Valor.

Chapter member, Ted Mosure, (SEAL, Vietnam) and Board member of the Ohio Military Hall of Fame briefed the membership on its "class of 2017" and ways to support the OMHOF. Donations can be made (the chapter made a modest donation); just go to its website: *ohioheroes.org*. Six brave men from our chapter will be inducted this year: Jeff Gallaher, Sean Clifton, Matt Schaeffer, Dustin Meyer, Matt Maxwell, and Jordan Grimshaw. **The ceremony is 5 May at 1130 hrs at the Ohio Statehouse Atrium in downtown Columbus**. This is a popular event and a standing room only (although there are seats for 250 people), so you are recommended to arrive early and be parked by 10 am in one of the many lots near the statehouse.

b. Golf Scramble Fundraiser.

The chapter will explore making this happen again during summer 2017. This was a successful fundraiser last year. **Roger Hobson** will ask Raccoon International Golf Club if they can host us again. If yes, then we will need chapter membership to begin soliciting \$100 hole sponsors and to find golfers at \$75 per greens fee.

c. <u>Pizza and Beer night Saturday **9 September**.</u>

Purpose is to enjoy mingling and story-telling between the men of B/2/19 and the retired SFA members at a location (TBD) near Rickenbacker ANGB. Most of the

d. 3 Gun Shoot 2017.

Mark Scott has locked this in with the great Americans at Pickaway County Sportsmen, Inc.

Event Date and location: Sunday 17 September 2017. Pickaway County Sportsmen, Inc. Circleville, OH

The 2017 Shoot will have different categories of shooters with awards for each category champion: 1) Sponsors, 2) \$500 registered shooters, 3) seniors (age 65+), and 4) active and retired SF guys (yes, you older guys can compete for more than one trophy).

The chapter needs members who can recruit one or more sponsors at \$1000, \$3000 or \$5000 each and for \$500 shooters. Event marketing material will be provided soon.

e. SF on the field during OSU Army Game at OSU.

The day prior to the Shoot, we will have a **Tailgate party Saturday 16 September 2017**. Location, time TBD. Sean Clifton has volunteered to lead this event.

f. Motorcycle Rally. Mark Arnold met again during December with the leadership of AD Farrow, Ohio's first and largest Harley Davidson dealership, to host this SFA 45 event for 2017. Tentative date is 23 September 2017 and a tentative plan follows:

6. **Employment of Chapter funds.** We discussed the following:

- O Scholarships for chapter members (and perhaps their family members) within B/2/19. We will ask a chapter member to draft rules and an addendum to the chapter by-laws on how this would be managed. This will provide more details in order to enable an informed vote on whether to support this initiative, or not.
- Support to the Green Beret Foundation. Discussed this, and determined it is another "one-off" type donation the chapter may vote upon to make from year to year. No plan to do it during 2017.
- Support the Ohio Fallen Heroes Memorial. Terry Dillon, a chapter member, is a founder of this, and he will look into whether and why a donation is warranted. It is expected that a donation is not warranted.
- Save the Montagnard People, a charity supported by SFA chapters in North Carolina. John McCort, a chapter member, will investigate this in detail during the SFA National Convention this year and report during July or
