The TREASURER'S REPORT

Danny Vinson reported the Chapter's combined balance of general fund and family support fund is \$56,664.68 as of 31 August 2018.

MEETING DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS (leads for actions noted in bold)

-Meeting agenda was outlined by Mark Arnold. Discussion items follow:

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Chapter member **Ed Wheeler** generously donated \$2000 to the chapter as a sponsor for the 3 Gun Shoot.
- 2. SFA 45 agrees to support an SF Gold Star Family. Chapter 68's President reached out to Mark Arnold regarding support to the SFA Convention in June 2019. It will be hosted by chapter 68 in Charleston, WV. Chapter 68 asked if chapter 45 could support the lodging expenses of hosting an SF Gold Star Family during the Convention; the estimated cost is \$650. The chapter members discussed the request and voted unanimously to support it.
- 3. <u>SFA Life membership offer to members of B/2/19 SFG</u>. The Chapter has had an open offer to pay \$300 of the \$440 total for members of B/2/19 SFG to become Life members. This offer has been open for three years. We discussed it and voted unanimously to end this offer as of 31 December. In this vote, the chapter also agreed to offer to pay \$300 of the \$440 total to any member of B/2/19 SFG who graduates SFQC and becomes a Life member within 12 months of graduation.
- 4. The chapter discussed the potential of creating a Scholarship Program. It would be two to four annual \$1000 grants of tuition assistance for chapter members and their immediate family. Definition follows: Chapter member, spouse, or direct lineal descendent of the chapter member; or be a legally adopted dependent or acknowledged by The Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) as a dependent of the chapter member. Tuition grant programs are normally for a four-year degree, but this program may include tuition assistance for private or public learning institutions other than a university and other than a bachelors degree. The chapter discussed this concept and voted unanimously to establish a Committee to propose the details of the Program so it can be discussed before 31 December and executed by February 2019. Action item for Mark Arnold and Tom McGrath.
- 5. **Kevin Colwell** discussed the Save a Warrior Program. It has a new facility in Newark, OH. Kevin will invite one of their members to brief the chapter during an upcoming meeting at AMVETS 89.
- 6. **Norm Lambert** agreed for **Patrick Enlow** to remove the WWII German medals from the framed print he donated to the chapter for auction. The medals will then be evaluated by experts for their value.

- PCSI established online registration for the Shoot on the website Practiscore.com. The website provides a one step-process for shooters to create a Practicescore.com account, then you search for SFA 45 within the website. Online registration is easy, and payment instructions and match details are emailed to the registered shooter. Registration is not confirmed until payment is received via mailed check or use of PayPal.


